

CREATIVE FABRICS

Teacher: Aurelia Masanet

- **DESCRIPTION:** This is a creative workshop, based on knowing and experimenting with fabrics and their possible applications, the different materials used, and so on. Students will plan and implement a fabric creation project.
- **OBJECTIVES:** to use fabrics as a way to foster curiosity, discover and explore other languages for plastic and creative expression. To provide students with the tools and knowledge they need to develop their expressive capacities.
- **METHODS:** Practical and creative workshop where students will learn the basic techniques to create fabrics: preparing the materials, putting them together, creating knots and ties...
Tapestry, carpets and walls as a reference. Practical
exercises to be carried out by students. Tailor-made follow-up for each
student so they can ask questions, receive feedback on possible changes and discuss creative options.
- **ADDRESSED TO:** Students interested in getting to know how to create a fabric, regardless of their previous knowledge on the subject.
- **ASSESSMENT:** Assessment criteria will be adapted to the students' level and will evaluate the design and execution of practical activities.
